



Shasta Raceway Park High School Challenge Series 2010

Mission:

To introduce high school and college-aged students to the challenge of competitive entry level oval track motorsports.

Goal:

To build or acquire a current Hornet class car for use as **High School Challenge Series (HSCS)** race car. The HSCS will be run as a stand-alone event pitting high school vs. high school. With booster, mentor, and family involvement increasing the exposure of motorsports to area high school youths. The end result will be to fill the grandstands and present a gateway to the fun of Hornet racing and beyond.

This program will offer a safe, organized, and enjoyable place to compete on a budget level in the ultra-adrenaline flowing sport of auto racing.

Eligibility:

Competitors must be currently enrolled in an area high school and or college students that are 14 – 20 years of age. Students must have a 2.5 gpa or better to compete.

Schedule:

There will be four HSCS events in 2010:

Saturday, May 15th

Sunday, June 20th, during the Shasta District Fair

Saturday, July 3rd, Anderson Explodes Fireworks

Saturday, August 28th

Publicity/Promotion:

SRP will utilize print, radio, web-based and television advertisements targeting high school aged youths in local Northern California communities.

Liability & Insurance:

Faeth Motorsports, Inc. the operators and promoters of Shasta Raceway Park maintain a \$3 Million liability insurance policy with K&K Motorsports Insurance. SRP also has \$50,000 of excess medical participant accident insurance and \$10,000 accidental death and dismemberment insurance. As with all motorsports insurance policies the track's insurance is secondary to a competitor's primary insurance. Please note that the SRP's track insurance policy requires all under-aged competitors to have a parental notice and minor's release waiver on file. These documents will be provided by SRP.

Costs & Awards:

Reduced Membership fees of \$20 will be available to HSCS competitors as well as reduced pit fees of \$20 per event. Points will be tabulated with the high school and the individual with the highest point total earning the HSCS track championship as well as a year-end trophy at the SRP banquet.

Details:

HSCS Cars must be **legal Hornet class cars**. Separate HS Challenge Series Points will be kept, a champion will be crowned and trophies awarded. HS Challenge Series Cars will be allowed to run paint schemes indicative of their home school.

Shasta Raceway Park maintains at least two firefighter EMT's at all our competitive race days. We have on-site mobile medical and fire-safety vehicles.

Technical inspections with an emphasis on safety will be done by the experienced staff of SRP.

Supervision & Administration:

SRP track personnel will provide each student racer with detailed instruction of rules, expectations, and track procedures pertaining to all aspects of racing at SRP and competing in the HSCS program. **Mr. Michael Bolduc**, the former Redding Drag Strip Track Operations Manager will be the **HSCS Program Administrator**. Mike has spent his entire life as a motorsports competitor, parts supplier, and administrator. Mike currently owns and operates Bolduc Performance Technologies a successful high performance carburetor business in Cottonwood, CA. Mike was instrumental in conceiving and launching the high school drag racing program at the Redding Drag Strip. Mike's years of motorsports experience and easily approachable demeanor make him the ideal candidate to administer this program.

FAQ's:

1. Can a HSCS competitor borrow or utilize a regular Hornet competitor's car to race in the HSCS program? **(Yes)**
2. Can an HSCS competitor compete with the regular Hornet Division? **(Yes)**
3. Can the HSCS cars be painted to represent school colors? (Yes, the hood and rear trunk lid may be painted to represent school colors? **(The sides of the cars must be yellow indicating that it is a Hornet Race Car)**)
4. Can more than one driver compete for the same school? **(Yes. The highest point total accumulated by a competitor will be awarded to that respective school per night while all other competitors' points will not be accumulated for that school. However *individual* competitor points will also be tabulated)**
